

Meeting Minutes

January 26, 2026

The Mayor and Board of Commissioners of the City of Sweetwater met in a called meeting and workshop session on Monday January 26, 2026 at 5:00 p.m. at City Hall. Mayor Angie Arp Kyle called the meeting to order with Commissioners present being: Branham L. Lovingood, Sam Moser, Alan Richeson, and James H. Stutts. City Attorney John Cleveland was present. A quorum was present.

No one was present to make a public comment on actionable items.

Commissioner Moser moved to approve a Resolution to declare a vacancy of the Mayor and Board of Commissioners of the City of Sweetwater. The motion was seconded. All voted in favor. The motion was carried.

DECLARING A VACANCY ON THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SWEETWATER, TENNESSEE


WHEREAS, Commissioner JoAnna Jinks has submitted her resignation from the Board of Commissioners of the City of Sweetwater; and

WHEREAS, Article IV, Section 7, of the Charter of the City of Sweetwater, Tennessee, provides, in pertinent part, as follows:

A vacancy shall exist, and the mayor and board of commissioners shall declare the same, by resolution, if ... a commission member ... resigns; now

THEREFORE, Be It Resolved that the Mayor and the Board of Commissioners of the City of Sweetwater, Tennessee, hereby declare a vacancy on the Board of Commissioners of the City of Sweetwater, Tennessee.

Commissioner Moser moved to appoint Mike Martin to fill the vacancy of the Mayor and Board of Commissioners. The motion was seconded. All voted in favor. The motion was carried.

The City Administrator gave an update including a quarterly financial report.

Mayor Kyle advised the board of the date and time of the inaugural Mayor's Hog Ball sponsored by SAMPOA. She advised that all proceeds would go to local charities as determined by the Hog Ball Board. She advised that SMPOA had submitted a Special Occasion Permit Application to ABC to allow alcoholic beverages to be served.

Mayor Kyle reviewed the agenda for the February 2, 2026 meeting.

The department heads gave their department reports.
